Its founders were visionary Aboriginal men and women from across regional New South Wales whose goal was to make a difference in Aboriginal people's lives. Over time, Birrang has expanded its activities to include people from other cultures and backgrounds, in response to identified needs and opportunities.

Birrang is a Not-for-profit Company with limited liability registered as a charity (Public Benevolent Institution) with the Australian Securities & Investments Commission (ASIC). Birrang is endorsed to receive income tax deductible gifts and tax-deductible contributions as a Deductible Gift Recipient (DGR).

Birrang is managed by a Board of Directors drawn from diverse geographical regions across New South Wales. Birrang employs a Chief Executive Officer and a team of qualified staff to administer its day-to-day operations at an office complex in Orange owned by Birrang.

- Employment support and advocacy
- Social enterprise development
